Event Safety Consent Form (Participant / Parent or Guardian)

In connection with the participant's entry in the 2026 ITF Open Tournament, the undersigned acknowledges that participation in competition involves inherent risks and that safety is of paramount importance. The undersigned agrees to comply with all safety requirements and accepts the following responsibilities to help protect the health, safety and welfare of the participant throughout the event.

1. Participant Health and Fitness to Compete

The undersigned confirms that the participant is in suitable physical condition prior to the competition, is fit to participate, and is able to safely undertake the intensity of the event. The participant does not have any medical condition that would make participation unsafe or unsuitable, including but not limited to cardiovascular disease, cerebrovascular disease, epilepsy, or any similar condition. By entering and participating in the competition, the participant and/or parent/guardian confirms that the participant's physical condition is suitable for competition.

2. Safety Instructions and Event Rules

- The undersigned will ensure safe travel to and from the venue and will comply with all applicable traffic rules and safety requirements.
- The undersigned will ensure that the participant is familiar with the environment inside and outside the venue. The participant must not run in unauthorised areas, touch electrical equipment, climb structures, or approach any hazardous areas or objects.
- The participant will take proper care of personal belongings, dispose of rubbish responsibly, and maintain respectful conduct while participating in or observing the competition.
- During sparring events, the participant will wear appropriate protective equipment and comply with correct sporting techniques, competition rules, and safety instructions.
- In the event of an emergency, the participant will follow all instructions issued by the event organisers, including any directions relating to evacuation or relocation.

Acknowledgement, Insurance and Responsibility

By signing this undertaking, the undersigned confirms that they have read, understood and agree to comply with the responsibilities set out above in order to support a safe competition environment.

Each participant is responsible for arranging and maintaining their own adequate insurance coverage. While the Organising Committee may provide limited event insurance, such coverage is restricted in scope and may not cover all injuries, losses, damages, medical expenses, or liabilities arising from participation. Accordingly, each participant acknowledges and accepts personal responsibility for any loss, injury, damage, cost, or expense not covered by the event insurance.

Any personal injury, property damage or other loss arising from the participant's own physical condition or other personal circumstances shall be borne by the participant and/or the participant's parent or legal guardian.
