Suzhou, China | 15-16 August 2026

Dear Masters ,Instructors ,Competitors, Umpires and Supporters:

On behalf of ITF China, we warmly invite you and your delegation to join us in Suzhou, China, for the 2026 ITF Open Tournament, to be held on 15-16 August 2026.

We look forward to welcoming overseas competitors, umpires, coaches, families and supporters to an event that celebrates the spirit of Taekwon-Do, international friendship and respectful exchange. This tournament brings together clubs, schools and practitioners from across China and abroad, united by the belief that the Taekwon-Do community is one family.

This event is strongly supported and endorsed by the local government, reflecting a shared commitment to sport development, cultural exchange, youth participation and international friendship through Taekwon-Do.

Now entering its 17th year, the ITF Open Tournament has become an important gathering for Taekwon-Do practitioners and supporters. From Beijing to Dalian, and from Kunshan to Suzhou, the event has continued to provide a valuable platform for competition, learning, connection and collaboration among ITF practitioners.

Suzhou is a beautiful city known for its classical gardens, rich cultural heritage and modern convenience. For guests travelling by air, the closest recommended airport is Sunan Shuofang International Airport (WUX) in Wuxi, the main regional airport serving Wuxi and Suzhou. It is approximately 30-40 km from central Suzhou by road, with a typical driving time of about 35-50 minutes, depending on traffic and the final hotel or venue location.

For travellers requiring broader international flight connections, Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport (SHA) and Shanghai Pudong International Airport (PVG) are also suitable options. Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport is approximately 85-90 km from Suzhou, normally around 1-1.5 hours by car, and is conveniently connected with Shanghai Hongqiao Railway Station for high-speed rail travel to Suzhou. Shanghai Pudong International Airport is approximately 130-145 km from Suzhou, usually around 2-2.5 hours by car depending on traffic, and is one of China's major international gateways.

Visitors may also enjoy the wider Yangtze River Delta region before or after the tournament. Suzhou offers classical gardens, historic canals, old streets and elegant local culture. Nearby Wuxi is known for lakeside scenery around Taihu Lake, while Shanghai, a larger city further away, offers international landmarks, shopping, dining and Shanghai Disney Resort. For those extending their stay, Hangzhou and Nanjing are also popular longer-distance destinations rich in culture, history and scenery.

We would be honoured to have you join us for this special event. Your participation will help make the 2026 ITF Open Tournament a memorable celebration of skill, discipline, friendship and the indomitable spirit of Taekwon-Do.

We look forward to welcoming you to Suzhou.

### 2. Fees and Optional Packages

The competition entry fee is USD 110 per competitor.

Accommodation is available at USD 160 per person, which includes three nights' accommodation and three breakfasts. Rooms are arranged on a twin-share basis, with two guests per room. This accommodation fee also includes one official dinner with the President.

For overseas groups of more than 15 people, airport or railway station pick-up may be arranged, subject to advance confirmation with the Organising Committee.

3. An optional full package is also available at USD 1,500 per person. This package includes two days of training, two days of competition, three days of sightseeing, meals, accommodation, transport and attraction entrance tickets. Delegations wishing to choose this package should contact the Organising Committee separately in advance so that arrangements can be properly confirmed.
